- Parade participation and position are solely at the discretion of the Payson Onion Days Executive Committee. Factors that may be considered are application return date and entry needs. Commercial and advertising entries will be strictly limited. All floats will be accepted. If you are a business and would like to utilize the parade for advertising, you may want to consider a business float.
- You will receive parade information via email by August 29.
- Entries are not allowed to be in the middle of the road. Park on the side of the road next to your assigned number. The shuttle needs room to drive and drop off participants.
- We will have 2 drop off zones for parade participants. Numbers 1-50 will park at Gene Hillman Complex parking lot at 955 South Main Street, (across from Payson High School). There will be a shuttle provided in front of Payson High School. Numbers 51-100 will be dropped off at Spring Lake Elementary 1750 South 500 West. There you will be shuttled to your float. Entries having participants shuttled must have an adult representative at shuttle pick up to take charge of children waiting for shuttle.
- All parade entries, (I. e. floats, vehicles) will be given instructions of where to check in by email a week before the parade. Parade entry must be staged by 9:00 am.
- **All parade participants must be staged by 9:30 am.**
- Entries must be parade ready when you arrive.
- Limited parking – please carpool or arrange for drop-off.
- Nothing can be thrown from an entry - distribute only.
- Required: One person walking by each tire if the entry will be distributing candy.
- Horse entries in charge of own clean up.
- **Do not create gaps in the parade line-up. If your dance group has a routine to perform it must be designed to permit CONSTANT FORWARD MOVEMENT. Please be considerate of other participants and spectators!! Violation may be cause for removal from the parade. Thank you for your cooperation.**
- Judging of entries will begin promptly at 9:00 am: Mayor's Choice, Queen's Choice, and Sweepstakes.
- Staging Address: Will be given a week before parade.
- Parade route address: 1150 South Main to 600 North

WAIVER & RELEASE OF DAMAGES AGAINST THE STATE OF UTAH AND PAYSON CITY FOR PARTICIPATION IN AN APPROVED SPECIAL EVENT ON STATE AND CITY ROADS

I, _____, the undersigned, representing entry or/and in behalf of all participants of entry, intending to be legally bound, hereby for myself, my family, my heirs, executors, and administrators, and for and in behalf of all participants of this entry, their families, their heirs, their executors, and administrators, forever waive, release and discharge any and all rights and claims for damages and causes of suit or action known or unknown, that we may have against the State of Utah, the Department of Transportation, the Utah Transportation Commission, the Utah Highway Patrol, their officers, agents, and employees, and the City of Payson, their officers, agents, political entities, and employees, including all Committee persons, Officials, Volunteers, and all sponsors and their officers, directors, employees, agents, and representatives, succors and assigns, for any and all injuries that may be suffered while participating in this event, Payson Onion Days 2024 Parade, September 2, 2024. Furthermore, I hereby affirm I have read this agreement and I understand its contents and agree to abide by the guidelines and parade route outlined in the parade application and reiterated by the Chief of Police, Brad Bishop, Payson City Police Department. Any deviation of route, except requested by such entity, declares entry as openly disobeying police authority and is cause for loss of participation by myself and all entities to which I represent forever here after. Further failure to observe these policies could result in legal action in a court of competent jurisdiction.
