## Pressurized Irrigation Notice to All Residents

The Payson City Water Department is in the process of ensuring that the Pressurized Irrigation system is operational for the 2021 season. We anticipate the pressurized irrigation water will be energized the first week in May 2021. Our sources for the pressurized irrigation comes from the lakes in Payson Canyon, with about 80% coming from Strawberry High Line Canal. We won't energize the system until the Canal starts up because we cannot sustain the use by the city residents with the water only coming from the lakes. Further information, with additional details, will be sent out on our phone system when it becomes available.

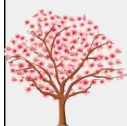
