Winter Parking Reminder

It's that time of year when snow will soon be covering our streets!

As a reminder, in order to facilitate the speedy and safe removal of snow from city streets, it is unlawful for the owner or driver of any vehicle to park, cause to be parked, or allowed to be parked, said vehicle upon any city street or right-of-way of a city street between the *hours of 10:30 p.m. and 7:00 a.m.* From *December 1st, through March 1st*, of the following year.



Snow Removal Guide

Payson City Street Department strives to maintain adequate snow removal for hazardous driving conditions. The following information will help residents better understand what to expect during the winter months for snow removal.

The City has established the following priorities for snow removal based on street classification and usage.

- Priority 1: All main arterial and collector streets
- Priority 2: Arterial and collector roads leading to or from school zones
- Priority 3: Secondary and residential streets
- Priority 4: Cul-de-sacs, roads with no outlets.

State Roads within Payson City limits maintained by UDOT:

- SR 198 (100 N & 100 W to city boundary)
- 800 S from SR 198 to I-15
- Main Street from 100 N to I-15



Home Energy Assistance Target Program (HEAT)

The Utah Home Energy Assistance Target (HEAT) program helps low-income households with their heating bills. This program provides winter utility assistance to low-income households targeting those who are truly vulnerable—the lowest-income households, disabled elderly, and families with preschool-age children. Parkour

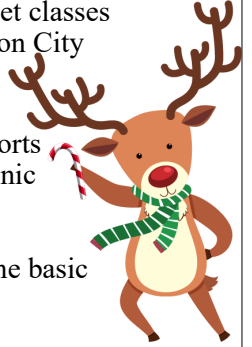
Parkour/sports readiness teaches the fundamentals of parkour moves and techniques including jumping and landing, rolling vaulting, connecting skills and falling safely.
