Pressurized Irrigation Notice

The pressurized irrigation system is being billed for the 2021 irrigation season like it has been previously. Starting with the 2022 irrigation season, the rates will be billed with a base rate and for the water used in 1,000-gallon increments. The rate that will be billed has not yet been adopted by the City Council but an irrigation calculator and information on ways to conserve water are located on our website at the following location:

There is also information on the website showing the stop and waste valve being turned on and off. The valve is designed to have water shoot out of it unless it is all of the way on or off to prevent it from freezing in the winter. If the water stops once the valve is on all the way you do not have a leak in the valve and the system is working normally.


