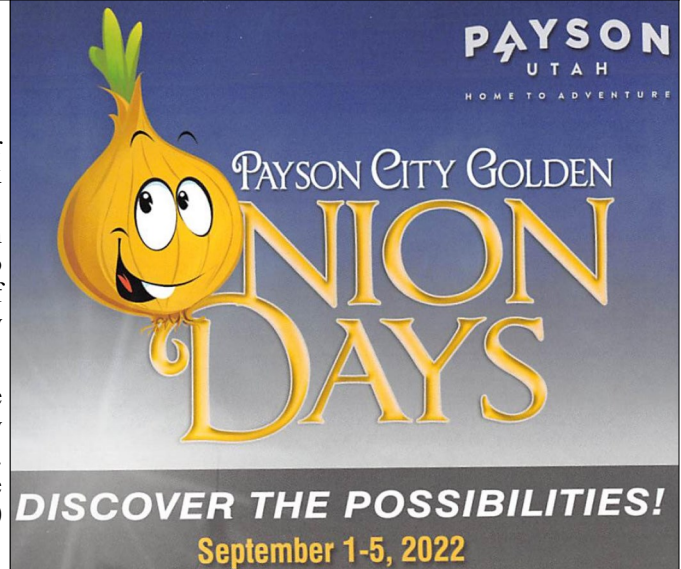
LABOR DAY GARBAGE SCHEDULE
