Equipment Operator – Streets

Applicants must have one year technical training or work experience in heavy equipment operation, construction or closely related field. Requires a valid Utah Commercial Driver's License (CDL).

Equipment Operator – Landfill

Applicants must have one-year technical training or work experience in heavy equipment operation or closely related field. Requires a valid Utah Driver's license. Winter Parking Reminder

Ordinance for parking will be in effect regardless of snow



As a reminder, in order to facilitate the speedy and safe removal of snow from city streets, it is unlawful for the owner or driver of any vehicle to park, cause to be parked, or allowed to be parked, said vehicle upon any city street or right-of-way of a city street between the **hours of 10:30 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. December 1st, through March 1st**, of the following year.
