I have received many requests to add a Mayor's message to our city's monthly Newsletter. I am excited to comply with your requests. This will allow me to answer some of your questions.

Many of you have noticed the UVU and M-Tech Banners on Main Street and 800 South. UVU has purchased almost 40 acres to build a satellite campus next to the future I-15 interchange that will be built approximately ¼ mile east of the existing Main Street Interchange within the next few years.

Mountainland Technical College (M-Tech) will build a campus on 13 ½ acres by the Red Bridge development on the west side of the 800 South I-15 interchange. It is a state-funded college, and funding has been approved; construction will start on the first building in the spring of 2023. The banners are a show of their commitment to Payson City. We are extremely excited and honored to welcome these higher education campuses to our city.
