

DID YOU KNOW? Back to School means sharing the road with our children. It is up to all of us to keep our children safe as they walk to and from school. As you drive throughout Payson; please be aware of the school

zones that lead to and from our children's schools. You will know you are near an active school zone when you observe the flashing lights have been activated on the school zone speed limit signs, you see crossing guards present, or see neon cones out near crosswalks. Pay extra attention to the two school zones located within blocks of each other on 800 South. The speed limit in a school zone while the lights are flashing is 20 mph per hour. If you are cited with exceeding the speed limit in a school zone it is a Class C misdemeanor. On your first offense the fine for 0-9 MPH over the speed limit is \$150; 10-19 MPH over is \$250, 20+ MPH over is \$450. A second speeding in a school zone violation within three years results in higher fines and could result in you being required to see the judge.

The pressurized irrigation system will be shut off the end of *September*.

The Payson City Landfill will be available at no charge for the cleanup projects within the city limits. Please observe the following:

- * Payson City will only accept discarded items that are collected from projects within the boundaries of Payson.
- * Landfill fees will only be waived for Payson residents.
- * Photo ID will be required to show proof of residency.
- * Loads must be properly secured and covered to prevent the disposal of litter and debris on public and private property and to avoid penalties and fines.
- * Hazardous waste, sealed containers of products, refrigerators and any kind of free liquid products will not be accepted.


