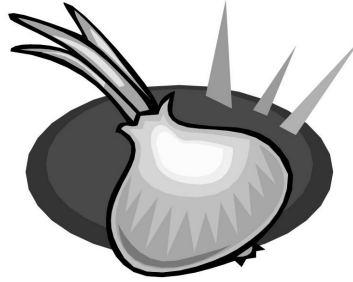
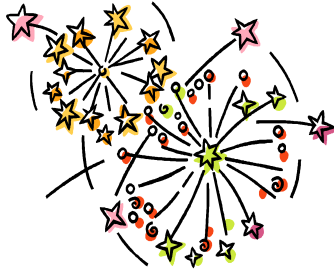

Utility Bill payments are due on **August 31st** (bills are always due the last business day of the month).
If you haven't yet paid your past due bill, please take care of it by **August 25th** to avoid shut off
and an additional service fee.

Payments made by 6:00 p.m. will be credited on the current business day.

Pressurized Irrigation Notice:

- ◆ Residents with *even numbered addresses* water on *Monday, Wednesday & Friday* only.
- ◆ Residents with *odd numbered addresses* water on *Tuesday, Thursday & Saturday* only.
- ◆ **Absolutely no watering on Sunday as this allows the system to recover.**
- ◆ Shorten watering times to about 15 to 20 minutes.
- ◆ The most effective times to water are during the evenings and mornings when temperatures are cooler. Therefore, residents are asked to refrain from watering between 10:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.

Payson City and other larger water users will be scheduled to use the water during the daytime hours in order to reserve as much pressure as possible for the residents.
