Municipal Election Notice

Payson City will be holding an Election this year for 3 Councilmembers. Qualified candidates wishing to fill out a Declaration of Candidacy must apply in person at the office of the Payson City Recorder, 439 West Utah Avenue, Payson, through July 15th, Monday - Friday from 7:30 a.m. - 6:00 p.m.

Candidates must meet the following qualifications as set forth in section 20A-9-203 U.C.A.:

- 1) Shall have been a resident of Payson or newly annexed area for at least 12 consecutive months immediately before the date of the election; and maintain residency within Payson City during the term of office; and
- 2) Shall be a registered voter; and
- 3) Any mentally incompetent person, any person convicted of a felony, or any person convicted of treason or a crime against the elective franchise may not hold office in this state until the right to hold elective office is restored under Section 20A-2-101.5, and
- 4) Shall sign a declaration that the person meets the qualifications and pay a \$50.00 filing fee.

Candidates for municipal offices shall be nominated at a regular primary election (Tuesday, September 13, 2011), if the number of candidates for a particular municipal office exceeds twice the number of persons needed to fill that office (7 candidates total). If the number of candidates is not twice the number needed, a primary for that office will not be held and all the candidates are considered nominated for the municipal general election on November 8, 2011.

All candidates are subject to financial disclosure requirements and the penalties associated with noncompliance (any candidate who fails to comply is guilty of an infraction and if a candidate fails to file a campaign finance statement before the deadline, the municipal clerk or recorder shall remove the candidate's name from the ballot).

Payson will provide early voting in the Payson City Office. If a Primary Election is needed, early voting will be August 30 - September 9, 2011 and early voting for the General Election will be October 25th - November 4th.

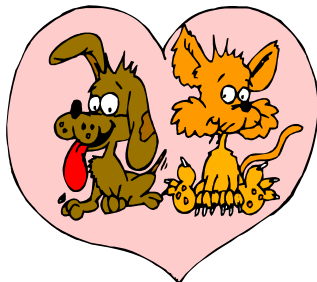

Utility Rate Increase

The Payson City Council has, by way of Resolution #06-15-11C, authorized a 1.2% rate increase for all utility services provided by Payson City. The increase is based on the Consumer Price Index for Fiscal Year 2011– 2011. Effective July 1, 2011.

Dog Licensing



Dog licenses may be purchased at the City Offices or from local veterinarians.

Also, to help ensure that all dogs are licensed, a Payson City representative will be going door-to-door to assist in this process.

Effective July 1, 2011 the cost for licensing dogs was increased to: \$20 for male/female; \$10 for neutered/spayed. *You will need proof of rabies vaccination.*

Pressurized Irrigation Notice:

- ◆ Residents with *even numbered addresses* water on *Monday, Wednesday & Friday* only.
- ◆ Residents with *odd numbered addresses* water on *Tuesday, Thursday & Saturday* only.
- ◆ **Absolutely no watering on Sunday as this allows the system to recover.**
- ◆ Shorten watering times to about 15 to 20 minutes.
- ◆ The most effective times to water are during the evenings and mornings when temperatures are cooler. Therefore, residents are asked to refrain from watering between 10:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.

Payson City and other larger water users will be scheduled to use the water during the daytime hours in order to reserve as much pressure as possible for the residents.

Utility Bill payments are due on **July 28th** (bills are always due the last business day of the month). If you haven't yet paid your past due bill, please take care of it by **July 21st** to avoid shut off and an additional service fee. Payments made by 6:00 p.m. will be credited on the current business day.
