### **Pressurized Irrigation Notice:**

- Residents with *even numbered addresses* water on *Monday, Wednesday & Friday* only.
- Residents with odd numbered addresses water on Tuesday, Thursday & Saturday only.
- Absolutely no watering on Sunday as this allows the system to recover.
- Shorten watering times to about 15 to 20 minutes.
- The most effective times to water are during the evenings and mornings when temperatures are cooler. Therefore, residents are asked to refrain from watering between 10am and 6pm.

Payson City and other larger Water users will be scheduled to use the water during the daytime hours in order to reserve as much pressure as Possible for the residents.

Utility Bill payments are due on **May 31st** (bills are always due the last <u>business</u> day of the month). If you haven't yet paid your past due bill, please take care of it by **May 26th** to avoid shut off and an additional service fee. Payments made by 6 pm will be credited on the current business day.
