Snow Removal

In order for the snow plows to clear the roads, no parking is allowed on city streets between 10:30 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. from December 1st through March 1st. This policy is referenced as City Ordinance *9.07.010*. Violation of this ordinance is an infraction and each day the violation occurs is considered a separate offense.

Snow removal for Payson City streets is completed in the following order:

- 1. Main arterial and collector roads.
- 2. Arterial and collector roads leading to or from school zones.
- 3. Secondary and residential streets.
- 4. Cul de sacs and roads with no outlets.



It is unlawful for any person to remove snow or ice from private property and place it on any public street, drive, or right-of-way. The Street Department Super-intendent may issue a written permit to any person to move or pile snow or ice on a public street or right-of-way if the superintendent determines it to be in the best interest of the City and residents of the area to do so. *Note: This does not apply to the removal of snow from sidewalks fronting private property which the owner or occupant has the duty to clean, nor to access driveways from a public street to private property.*

Christmas Tree Disposal

Christmas trees can be taken to the following locations:

- City Center parking lot (439 W. Utah Avenue)
- Memorial Park northeast parking lot (200 S. Main)
- Payson City Landfill (6220 W. 10400 S.)

Please do not put trees in garbage cans!

Trees will not go through the hopper on our residential collection trucks, and therefore,

cans containing trees will not be dumped.

Time to Purchase Dog Licenses

Dog licenses may be purchased at the Payson City Offices or from local veterinarians.

You will need proof of rabies vaccination.

If you purchase your license before February 1st,
you will receive a \$2 discount off the regular price of \$20
for male/female; \$10 for neutered/spayed
