### I-15 Payson to Spanish Fork Project

UDOT has begun the widening of more than seven miles of Interstate 15 (I-15) between Payson and Spanish Fork. The project will use the median area and add a lane and shoulder to each side of I-15. This project will help alleviate current travel conditions by adding capacity for the efficient movement of people, goods and services for decades to come. UDOT is committed to completing the project with little inconvenience to the public and keeping drivers informed of the minimal impacts in a timely and accurate manner. Expected completion of the project is late fall 2013.
