Snow Removal



In order to facilitate the speedy and safe removal of snow from city streets, please note the following in accordance with Payson City Ordinance 9.07.010: No parking is allowed on city streets between 10:30 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. from December 1st through March 1st. It is unlawful for any person to remove any snow or ice from any private property and place it on any public street, sidewalk, drive, or right-of-way. The Street Department Superintendent may issue a written permit to any person to move or pile snow or ice on a public street or right-of-way if the Superintendent determines it to be in the best interest of the City and residents of the area to do so (*this does not apply to the removal of snow from sidewalks fronting private property which the owner or occupant has the duty to clean, nor to access driveways from a public street to private property*).

Payson City Offices will be closed from 11:00 a.m. on December 24th until 7:30 a.m. December 26th for Christmas, and also on New Year's Day, January 1st.



Christmas trees can be dropped off at the following locations for disposal:
City Center parking lot,
Memorial Park north parking lot
or the Landfill.

Do not put trees in residential cans or dumpsters.

Utility Bill payments are due on **December 31st** (the last business day of the month). If you haven't yet paid your past due bill, please take care of it by **December 26th** to avoid shut off and an additional service fee. Payments made by 6:00 p.m. will be credited on the current business day.

Holiday Garbage Pick Up

If your garbage pick up day falls on *Wednesday, December 25th*, your garbage will be picked up *Thursday, December 26th*.

If your garbage pick up day falls on *Wednesday, January 1st*, your garbage will be picked up on *Thursday, January 2nd*.
