Due to HB 403 that was passed during the 2013 Legislative Session and effective May 1, 2013, **the NEW Candidate Filing Period begins June 3, 2013.**

Declaration of Candidacy Forms or Nomination Petition must be filed in person with the City Recorder at 439 West Utah Avenue, Payson, Utah during regular office hours Monday – Thursday between the hours of 7:30 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.

**Candidate Filing Deadline this year will be
Monday, June 10, 2013 at 6:00 p.m.**



Pressurized Irrigation Notice:

- ◆ Residents with *even numbered addresses* water on *Monday, Wednesday & Friday* only.
- ◆ Residents with *odd numbered addresses* water on *Tuesday, Thursday & Saturday* only.
- ◆ ***Absolutely no watering on Sunday as this allows the system to recover.***
- ◆ Shorten watering times to about 15 to 20 minutes.
- ◆ The most effective times to water are during the evenings and mornings when temperatures are cooler. Therefore, residents are asked to refrain from watering between 10am and 6pm.

Payson City and other larger water users will be scheduled to use the water during the daytime hours in order to reserve as much pressure as possible for the residents.

Your cooperation in adhering to these requirements is greatly appreciated.



***Snowpack in Payson Canyon is less than 10% of normal.
To ensure that we have enough water to last through the season,
Payson City will strictly enforce the regulations and cite violators.

Payson City's Tentative Budget again includes making transfers in the 2013-2014 Fiscal Year from the following Utility Funds TO the General Fund, Vehicle Maintenance, and Information Technology. The purpose of such transfers is to help cover services that are provided for these utilities and for the citizens through the General Fund (Administrative Services, Community Development, Development Services, Public Safety, Streets, Parks, Swimming Pool, Youth and Senior Recreation, Library, and Cemetery). Also included is a transfer FROM the General Fund to the Golf Course (to cover Golf Course Expenditures):
