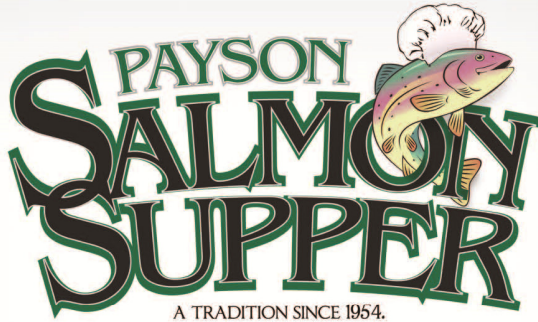
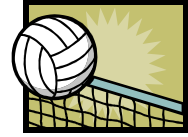

Utility Bill payments are due on **July 31st** the last business day of the month). If you haven't yet paid your past due bill, please take care of it by **July 23rd** to avoid shut off and an additional service fee. Payments made by 6:00 p.m. will be credited on the current business day.
