Typically, each Planning Commissioner serves a four (4) year term and commissioners may reapply for additional terms.

What TO bring:

- Medications
- Gasoline / fuels / motor oil / lubricants
- Old gas cans will be exchanged for newer, environmentally friendly cans
- Antifreeze
- Solvents / paint thinners
- Aerosol cans / paints / stains
- Pesticides / herbicides
- Glues / adhesives
- Fluorescent light bulbs
- Mercury thermometers
- Photographic chemicals
- Electronics (limit 2 sets per vehicle)
- Paper for Shredding
- Glass bottles and jars

What NOT:

- Containers over 5 gallons in size
- Ammunition/ explosives **NO!**
- Compressed gas tanks / propane tanks
- Asbestos materials
- PCB- related materials
- Medical / biological waste
- Radioactive waste
- Fire extinguishers
- Business / commercial / construction waste
- Tires

Please do not mix wastes (bring in original containers if possible). Waste must be capped or sealed.

 Main Street & Interstate 15

The Utah Department of Transportation (UDOT) and Payson City are preparing an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) to evaluate the interchange at Main Street (SR-115) and I-15. The study will evaluate transportation conditions and recommend a solution that meets current and future needs.
