RESIDENTIAL RECYCLING PROGRAM

Recycling Facts

- * Recycling 1 aluminum can saves enough energy to power your television for 3 hours
- * Recycling 1 ton of paper saves 17 trees
- * Recycling 1 ton of plastic conserves the same amount of energy consumed by two people in 1 year
- * Recycling 1 ton of cardboard saves 46 gallons of oil.

OPT-OUT PERIOD

August 15 - October 15, 2016

If you do not want to participate in the recycling program, fill out the opt-out form (included in the utility bill) and return it to the Payson City office by October 15th. Anyone who does not fill out and return the opt-out form will be part of the recycling program and will be billed monthly at the following rate:

65% or greater participation \$5.50 per month 50 % to less than 65% participation \$6.25 per month 25 % to less than 50% participation \$7.50 per month

A waste recycling can will be delivered in October and bi-monthly pick-up service will begin in November. Residents will be notified later what day of the week their can will be emptied. For a list of what can be put in the recycle can, visit our website at www.paysonutah.org.

Each year after the initial set up, there will be a two-week opt-out period in October, but Residents can choose to participate at any time. If you have any questions, please contact our office at 801-465-5200, Monday – Thursday, 7:30 am – 6:00 pm.
