Snow Removal

In order to facilitate the speedy and safe removal of snow from city streets, please note the following in accordance with Payson City Ordinance 9.07.010: No parking is allowed on city streets between 10:30 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. from December 1st through March 1st. It is unlawful for any person to remove any snow or ice from any private property and place it on any public street, sidewalk, drive, or right-of-way. The Street Department Superintendent may issue a written permit to any person to move or pile snow or ice on a public street or right-of-way if the Superintendent determines it to be in the best interest of the City and residents of the area to do so (*this does not apply to the removal of snow from sidewalks fronting private property which the owner or occupant has the duty to clean, nor to access driveways from a public street to private property*).



Change in Equal Pay Amount

This is the month Payson City evaluates all equal pay accounts. Please review your bill carefully to see if your equal pay amount has changed. If you use automatic payments, please make the appropriate changes if needed.

Christmas Tree Disposal

Christmas trees can be taken to the following locations:

- City Center parking lot (439 W. Utah Avenue)
- Memorial Park northeast parking lot (200 S. Main)
- Payson City Landfill (6220 W. 10400 S.)

Please do not put trees in garbage cans!

Trees will not go through the hopper on our residential collection trucks, and therefore, **cans containing trees will not be dumped.**



Time to Purchase Dog Licenses

Dog licenses may be purchased at the Payson City Offices or from local veterinarians.

You will need proof of rabies vaccination.
