IMPORTANT: NEW WATER RATES EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2016

Payson City Council approved a <u>total</u> \$6 monthly <u>base</u> rate increase: \$3 in culinary and \$3 in pressurized irrigation systems which are vital to accomplish the following:

- * Repair current deficiencies in the system
- ★ Install meters to encourage water conservation
- ★ Pursue additional water sources

The Council also adopted a <u>tiered</u> culinary water rate to comply with State Bill 28 *Water System Conservation Pricing* that was passed during the 2016 Legislative Session.

Payson City Recycling Program



Payson City received many inquiries regarding curbside recycling. More requests and inquiries came in when the recycling bins located at the local schools were removed by the recycling company. The City has entered into a five-year contract with Republic Services to provide curbside recycling. This is an "Opt-

out" program, so residents will have a window of time to choose not to participate.

The opt-out period will be August 15 through September 30, 2016.

After the Sept. 30th deadline, residents who have not opted out will be part of the program. Recycling cans will be delivered to each resident and the monthly charge for the service will be added to the utility bill.

The cost to the residents who choose to take advantage of this service will depend upon the number of residents who participate in the program.

65% or greater participation: \$5.50 per month 50% to less than 65% participation: \$6.25 per month 25% to less than 50% participation: \$7.50 per month

The recycling service will be collected every other week.

Change in Equal Pay Amount

This is the month Payson City evaluates all equal pay accounts.

Due to the increase in water rates,

ALL equal pay amounts will increase a minimum of \$6.00/month.

Please review your bill carefully to see what your equal pay amount has been changed to.

PAYSON CITY PRESSURIZED IRRIGATION WATER SCHEDULE

Residents shall water with the Pressurized Irrigation system three (3) times per week as set forth below:

- All water users with **ODD** numbered addresses shall water only on **Tuesday**, **Thursday and Saturday**. All water users with **EVEN** numbered addresses shall water only on **Monday**, **Wednesday and Friday**.



Watering times are from midnight to 10:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. to midnight. It is recommended that pop-up sprinkler heads operate at 20 minutes or less and rotating sprinkler heads operate at 30 minutes or less. There shall be **NO** watering on **SUNDAYS**, to allow the system to recover. There shall be no hard-surface washing of driveways and parking lots.
