The Payson City Landfill will be available at no charge during March 26th to April 9th for cleanup projects within the city limits. Individuals participating in the city-wide cleanup must observe the following:

- Payson City will only accept discarded items that are collected from projects within the boundaries of Payson.
- Landfill fees will only be waived for Payson residents. Be prepared to present proof of residence, such as a utility bill or photo ID.
- Loads must be properly secured and covered to prevent the disposal of litter and debris on public and private property to avoid penalties and fines.
- Hazardous waste, sealed containers of products, refrigerators, and any kind of free liquid products will not be accepted.
- Landfill hours: Monday through Friday 8:00 am to 5:00 pm through March 31 and beginning April 1st, hours will be Monday through Friday 8:00 am to 5:00 pm. Saturday 8:00 am to 7:00 pm. Closed Sunday

All applications must be submitted to the Payson City Recorder no later than 6:00 p.m. on Tuesday March 15, 2016

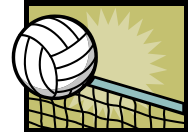
