Payson City will conduct elections this year for the following positions.


One (1) Mayor Position – Four (4) year term Two (2) City Council Member Positions – Four (4) year term each

The candidate filing period begins Thursday, June 1, 2017 and ends Wednesday, June 7, 2017. A Declaration of Candidacy Form or Nomination Petition must be filed in person with the Payson City Recorder, 439 West Utah Avenue, Payson, Utah during regular office hours Monday - Thursday between 7:30 am and 6:00 pm and then also on Friday June 2nd between 8:00 am and 5:00 pm.
