ELECTIONS 2017

Payson City will be conducting an all VOTE-BY-MAIL ELECTION this year.

Following are a few important points to be aware of:



1. Visit VOTE.UTAH.GOV to ensure you are registered to vote, update voter information, and learn about the candidates running for office.
2. There will be no polling locations on the day of the election for both the Primary and the General Election.
3. Ballots will be mailed to registered voters July 25th, 21 days before the Primary Election.
4. Ballots will have pre-paid postage. You can simply put the completed ballots in your mailbox or return them to the Payson City offices.
5. Ballots need to be postmarked **by August 14th**.

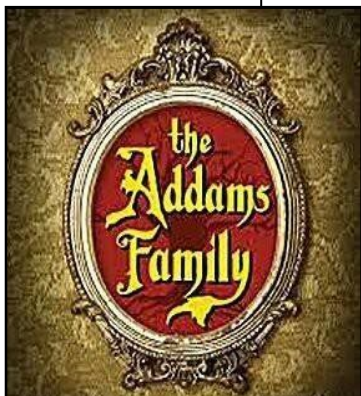
