

ELECTIONS 2017

Payson City will be conducting an all VOTE-BY-MAIL ELECTION this year.

Following are a few important points to be aware of:

Visit VOTE.UTAH.GOV to ensure you 1. are registered to vote, update voter information, and learn about the candidates running for office.



- 2. There will be no polling locations on the day of the election for both the Primary and the General Elec-
- tion. Ballots will be mailed to registered voters July 25th, 3. 21 days before the Primary Election.
- 4. Ballots will have pre-paid postage. You can simply put the completed ballots in your mailbox or return them to the Payson City offices.
- 5. Ballots need to be postmarked by August 14th.
