In order to facilitate the speedy and safe removal of snow from city streets,

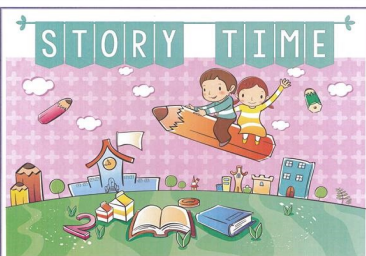
No parking is allowed on city streets between 10:30 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. from December 1st through March 1st.
