ELECTIONS 2017

General Election Day is November 7, 2017

Payson City will be conducting an all VOTE-BY-MAIL ELECTION this year. Following are a few important points to be aware of:

- 1. Visit VOTE.UTAH.GOV to ensure you are registered to vote, update voter information, and learn about the candidates running for office.
- 2. There will be no polling locations on the day of the General Election.
- 3. Ballots will be mailed to registered voters around October 17th, 21 days before the General Election.
- 4. Ballots will have pre-paid postage. You can simply put the completed ballots in your mailbox or return them to the Payson City offices.
- 5. Ballots need to be postmarked by November 6th.






CAASA-Communities Acting Against Substance Abuse
