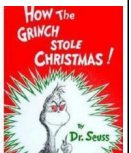

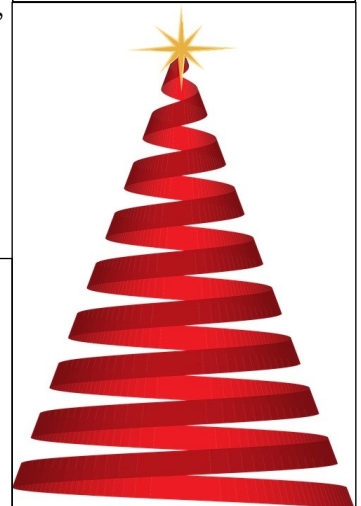

## Home Energy Assistance Target Program (HEAT)

The Utah Home Energy Assistance Target (HEAT) program helps low-income households with their heating bills. This program provides winter utility assistance to low-income households targeting those who are truly vulnerable—the lowest-income households with the highest heating costs and disabled elderly, and families with preschool-age children. Payments made after 5:00 p.m. will be credited on the next business day.
