On August 8, 2018, Payson City Memorial Park will be transformed into the start and finish line for Stage 2 of the Tour of Utah.




Payson City Memorial Park will be filled with activities for all ages, as well as food vendors and entertainment. Admission is free and is open to the public.

We hope you will be able to Save the Date and join us on August 8 for a celebration you won't want to miss.



The Open Burn periods for Utah County in 2018 are March 30 to May 30 and September 15 to October 30.
