# Vote by Mail 2018

#### HOW DO I RETURN MY VOTED BALLOT?

You may return your voted ballot by mail. Postage is required. Return your ballot early to ensure it is counted in the Election Night reports. BALLOTS MUST BE POSTMARKED ON OR BEFORE NOVEMBER 5.

Save a stamp and drop your ballot at one of our drop locations in most City Recorders Offices.

#### WHAT IF I DID NOT RECEIVE A BALLOT?

If you did not receive your ballot in the mail, you will need to update your voter registration at vote.utah.gov

#### SOME VOTERS MAY NEED TO VOTE IN PERSON

If you did not receive a ballot or you need the amenities of the electronic voting equipment, you may vote in person during the Early Voting Period:

Oct. 30, 31 and Nov. 1,2. Or, on Election Day November 6 at any of our 24 Voter Service Centers. *Be sure to bring ID and proof of residency*.

#### **FALL CLEAN UP**

October 6th through October 13th

The Payson City Landfill will be available at no charge for the cleanup projects within the city limits. Please observe the following:

- \* Payson City will only accept discarded items that are collected from projects within the boundaries of Payson.
- \* Landfill fees will only be waived for Payson residents.
- \* Photo ID will be required to show proof of residency.
- \* Loads must be properly secured and covered to prevent the disposal of litter and debris on public and private property and to avoid penalties and fines.
- \* Hazardous waste, sealed containers of products, refrigerators and any kind of free liquid products will not be accepted.

#### September 15 to October 30

This open burning allows residents to burn clippings, bushes, plants, and prunings from trees incident to property clean-up activities. PLEASE follow all guidelines given when applying for permit.
