I.D.D.E.— Illicit Discharge Detection and Elimination



Please keep an eye on your dumpsters, garbage cans and storm inlets in your neighborhoods for illicit dumping of any kind.

Payson City, with the help of the Utah Division of Water Quality and the EPA are working together to keep the waters of Utah Lake clean and chemical free. 
