# **ELECTIONS 2019**

General Election Day is **November 5, 2019** 

Payson City will be conducting an all VOTE-BY-MAIL ELECTION this year as well as RANK CHOICE VOTING.

Please be aware of the following points.

- Visit VOTE.UTAH.GOV to ensure you are registered to vote, update voter information, and learn about the candidates running for office.
- Visit UTAHRCV.COM to better understand Rank Choice Voting and watch the city's website for additional information.
- There will be no polling location on the day of the General Election. A voting center will be open on Election Day from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. at the Payson City Center, Banquet Hall, 439 W Utah Avenue, for voter assistance and provisional voting.
- Ballots will be mailed to registered voters around October 15<sup>th</sup>, 21 days before the General Election.
- Ballots will have prepaid postage. Simply put the completed ballot in your mailbox or return it to the Payson City Center.
- Ballots must be postmarked by November 4<sup>th</sup>.
