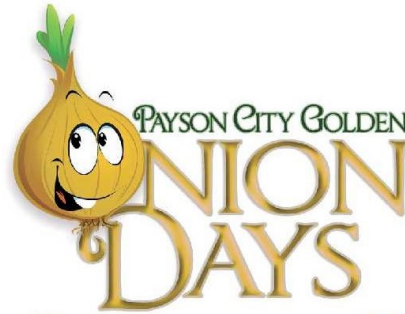

PUBLIC HEARING & ADOPTION

A public hearing has been scheduled to receive public input on the draft documents associated with the *Imagine Payson* update of the Payson City General Plan. In addition to the general plan, the update includes a strategic plan and master plans for culinary water, pressurized irrigation, wastewater, storm drain, and transportation. The public may review the plans by visiting the project website at www.imaginepayson.com.

The public hearing will be conducted during the regular meeting of the city council on Wednesday August 19, 2020. The meeting begins at 6:00 pm and will be conducted electronically via Zoom Meetings. The meeting link will be available on the Payson City website at www.paysonutah.org at least 24 hours prior to the meeting.
