As a reminder, in order to facilitate the speedy and safe removal of snow from city streets, it is unlawful for the owner or driver of any vehicle to park, cause to be parked, or allowed to be parked, said vehicle upon any city street or right-of-way of a city street between the **hours of 10:30 p.m. and 7:00 a.m.** From **December 1st, through March 1st**, of the following year.

Door to Door Salespeople and Your Safety

Payson Residents,
Your safety is important to us. If you have a solicitor come to your door, politely ask to see their Payson City solicitor's license. Payson City requires a background check and license to go door to door. You should always exercise caution when inviting a stranger into your home.

If they do not have a license they have not been checked out by Payson City. We advise you do not let them in and politely ask them to leave, you can notify the City Police if necessary. It is unlawful to solicit door to door without a city issued license.

Regardless of having a license or not, salespeople must treat you with respect and must leave your home when you ask them to. If they do not you should notify police immediately. 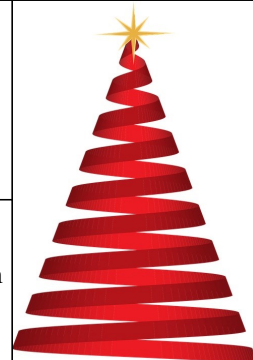
