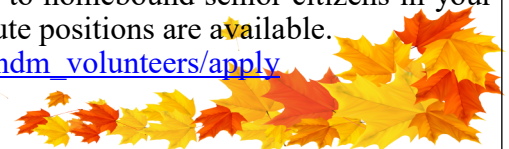

WINTER PARKING REMINDER

It's that time of year when snow will soon be covering our streets!

As a reminder, in order to facilitate the speedy and safe removal of snow from city streets, it is unlawful for the owner or driver of any vehicle to park, cause to be parked, or allowed to be parked, said vehicle upon any city street or right-of-way of a city street between the *hours of 10:30 p.m. and 7:00 a.m.* From *December 1st, through March 1st*, of the following year.

Story Time Traditional storytime hasn't started up again yet, but we have created a new program: DIY Storytime! Each week, you can visit an online storytime guide centered on a particular theme. The storytime guide has book readings, activities, songs, rhymes, etc. Corresponding craft kits can be picked up at the library each week.

Books & Boys is on Thursday, November 19th at 7pm. We will be discussing the book "The Sasquatch Escape" by Suzanne Selfors. Open to boys ages 8+ with a parent or caregiver. Masks are required.

Young at Heart Book Club (a book club for adults who enjoy reading Junior Fiction) is on Friday, November 20th at 6pm. They will be discussing Nancy Drew books—read any Nancy Drew book to prepare. Open to ages 18+. Masks are required.

Book Club is on Tuesday, November 17th at 8pm. They will be discussing "Carry On, Mr. Bowditch" by Jean Lee Latham, Winner of the 1956 Newbery Medal. Open to ages 16+. Masks are required.
