Utah County Elections Office (801-851-8128)

What voters need to know:



- Ballots will be mailed the week of October 12. If a voter does not have a ballot by October 16, they should contact the Utah County Elections Office at 801-851-8128. Information relating to dropbox locations, ballot pick-up locations, early voting, who/what is on the ballot, etc. can all be found at UtahCounty.Vote
- The Utah County Elections Office is encouraging voters to return their voted ballot at any of the secured drop boxes located throughout the county. [Dropbox locations can be found here.](#) Payson City's drop box is located on the north side of the City Center building, 439 W Utah Avenue (drive through).
- The deadline to postmark your ballot is November 2, the day **before** Election Day. If a voter returns their ballot at a post office, they need to confirm that their ballot will be postmarked before Election Day.
- Early Voting is available on October 28 - 30, and November 2, at the Utah County Elections Office, 100 East Center Street, Suite 3100, Provo UT 84606.
- Ballot pick-up locations will be available on Election Day. Locations will be open from 7:00 AM to 8:00 PM on Election Day and Utah laws permitting same-day registration via provisional ballots will be in effect on Election Day. [Locations can be found here.](#) Payson's location is at the Payson Utah Stake Center, 650 West 800 South.
- The Utah County Elections Office provides voters with disabilities accessible options to cast their ballot. A voter with a disability can contact our office at Elections@UtahCounty.Gov or call our office at 801-851-8128 for more information.

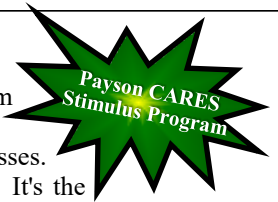

Payson City Residents and Business Stimulus Program

Payson City is pleased to announce the Payson City CARES Act Stimulus Program for the month of October 2020. Five-\$10 coupons were mailed to each household a few days ago. These coupons can be used as cash at participating Payson businesses. This is a great benefit for you and in turn will help our Payson City Businesses. It's the perfect time to get out and use your coupons!



Use your coupons at one or more of the "Participating Businesses". You can use all of your coupons at a single business, however, we encourage you to shop at five different Payson businesses. If you do, you can enter into to a drawing for one of seven, \$200 prizes.

To be eligible for the drawing, you must use one coupon at five different participating businesses. At checkout you surrender your coupon and present the \$200 Prize Drawing Entry Card, which came with your coupons, for a signature from the participating business. Once you collect signatures from five different business, turn in the \$200 Prize Drawing Entry Card into the Payson City Office, 439 West Utah Avenue, no later than November 10, 2020. Cards may be dropped off in-person M-TH 7:30 am to 6:00 pm or left in the drop box.
