# **ELECTIONS 2020**

# **Utah County Elections Office (801-851-8128)** What voters need to know:



- Ballots will be mailed the week of October 12. If a voter does not have a ballot by October 16, they should contact the Utah County Elections Office at 801-851-8128. Information relating to dropbox locations, ballot pick-up locations, early voting, who/what is on the ballot,
- The Utah County Elections Office is encouraging voters to return their voted ballot at any of the secured drop boxes located throughout the county. Dropbox locations can be found here. Payson City's drop box is located on the north side of the City Center building, 439 W Utah Avenue (drive through).
- The deadline to postmark your ballot is November 2, the day **before** Election Day. If a voter returns their ballot at a post office, they need to confirm that their ballot will be postmarked before Election Day.
- Early Voting is available on October 28 30, and November 2, at the Utah County Elections Office, 100 East Center Street, Suite 3100, Provo UT 84606.
- Ballot pick-up locations will be available on Election Day. Locations will be open from 7:00 AM to 8:00 PM on Election Day and Utah laws permitting same-day registration via provisional ballots will be in effect on Election Day. Locations can be found here. Payson's location is at the Payson Utah Stake Center, 650 West 800 South.
- The Utah County Elections Office provides voters with disabilities accessible options to cast their ballot. A voter with a disability can contact our office at Elections@UtahCounty.Gov or call our office at 801-851-8128 for more information.

The Payson City Landfill will be available at no charge for the cleanup projects within the city limits. Please observe the following:

- \* Payson City will only accept discarded items that are collected from projects within the boundaries of Payson.
- \* Landfill fees will only be waived for Payson residents.
- \* Photo ID will be required to show proof of residency.
- \* Loads must be properly secured and covered to prevent the disposal of litter and debris on public and private property and to avoid penalties and fines.
- \* Hazardous waste, sealed containers of products, refrigerators and any kind of free liquid products will not be accepted.
