# 4. <u>Update on MTECH Kirt Michaelis</u>

MTECH in now landowners in Payson City. Kirk shared a 3d photo of the proposed facility. The facility will be around 86,000 square feet. They are hoping to break ground mid to late summer. The facility will offer a Manufacturing Lab, Culinary Arts Program, as well as Welding, Automotive and Diesel Labs on the 1<sup>st</sup> floor. The 2<sup>nd</sup> floor will offer Health Care Programs such as, Pharmacy Tech, Medical Assistant, Dental Assistant & Nursing Assistant. There will also be a training room available to the public.

MTECH is currently working with the States Commission's artist to provide artwork for the buildings. They are excited to bring this campus to Payson. They are hoping the building will be finished up in time for classes in January 2025.

# 5. Committee Reports and Assignments

Brian would like the chair committee members to bring their ideas/goals from their meetings back to the EDC meeting.

Ty Jones reported about the infrastructure on Main Street he believes from the freeway to downtown is set to have a facelift in the Spring. Once the construction moves down Main Street, one of the goals is to help the business owners understand they need to update their business access from the front to the rear.

Ty mentioned an event at the Huish Theater on the 18<sup>th</sup> of March. They are accepting any donations for the event they are looking for swag, money, or prizes to give away.

Mark Kershaw talked to Olsen's Nursery they would like to continue partnering with the city for projects that Parks & Rec have. Also, being considered for other businesses needing plants and trees around the city.

David Charles talked to Payson Fruit Growers; they said last year was not a good year for them. They were about 60% of the normal from their crop last year, this year weather dependent things are looking good for water which was a factor last year.
