COED RULES "2024"

- 1. Rosters need to be filled out as complete as possible at deadline date with signatures. After the season begins rosters will be available at the ballpark score tower until the end of the second week of play. You may add players to that roster without question until that time. After the second week rosters are final and will be taken to the rec. office, any additions after that time must be approved by rec. director, After the fourth week rosters cannot change for any reason (Remember that before a player steps on the field they need to sign the team's roster).
- 2. NO DOGS, ALCOHOL OR TOBACCO ALLOWED IN THE BALL PARK.
- 3. All players must be 18 years of age, and graduated from high school as of MAY 31, 2024 to be on a roster. All teams will be required to have shirts with numbers on the back any violations will be a run to the other team before the game begins. Team captains need to provide lineups to scorekeepers before each game.
- 4. A team may play with a **minimum of eight players**, four women & four men.
- 5. A team may bat everyone, alternating a man and a women. If a team has more men than women in the linup they may chose to take an automatic out in place of the missing Women or substitute the mens spot in the linup.
- 6. Game time will start as scheduled (if umpire is present), or after previous game is over. There is a 10 minute grace period before a forfeit is called. Once the umpire has declared a forfeited game they are not required to Officiate that game.
- 7. There will be a 3 homerun limit per game for **men only**, women are unlimited.
- 8. We will play with an outfield burn line for women only this means that when a woman is up to bat all outfield defense must remain behind outfield painted line until the ball is hit. Along with this rule when a woman is at bat all infield players need to remain on infield dirt until ball is hit.
- 9. Games will be played 7 innings or 50 minutes. There will be a 10 run rule after 5, 15 after 4 and a 20 after 3. (FLIP FLOP RULE MAY ALSO BE USED)
- Defensive players must be even number men and women, (example) 2 outfield & 2 Infield (1 catcher or pitcher).
- 11. Only players on the roster will be allowed on the playing field **INCLUDING DUGOUTS.** Violations of this rule may result in forfeiture of the game.(ABSOLUTELY NO CHILDREN) Players can only play on one team per night.
- 12. Courtesy runners, 1 per gender, per team, per inning. Courtesy runners may be any one on your team and can run for any player no matter what base they are occupying . However if said runners at bat comes while they are on base it will be an out in that batting spot. Runners must be used before next pitched ball.
- 13. Teams will **not** be allowed to **warm up** in main entrance (walkway) to park, on or across any concrete Inside the park, be cautious where you warm up for your safety and the safety of others. Please have your spectators sit in bleacher area.
- 14. Team prizes will be given 1st & 2nd in tournament. Teams may be moved up To a higher tournament bracket and possibly a different night depending on ability, 14 prizes will be given per team.
- 15. If a man gets walked he will automatically move on to second base. Women must bat if there are less than 2 outs. With 2 outs women will have a choice to bat or walk.
- 16. All bats must be official 2012 Or newer NSA, ISA or USSSA Stamped bats.
- 17.. All other NCS rules will apply.

CODE OF CONDUCT

- Any player ejected from a game or facility, by an umpire or field supervisor for the following reasons will be suspended for that game plus next
 scheduled game and placed on probation for rest of the season. Second ejection player will be suspended from league until player has met with
 Recreation Director.
 - a. Abusive language before, during or after game to umpire, field supervisor or any other participant.
 - b. Rough tactics, cheating, unfair play, using illegal equipment i.e. (Steele spikes, illegal bat).
 - c. Arguing with umpire, field supervisor or other staff.
 - d. Drinking or smoking at ballpark facility.
 - e. Intentionally abusing ballpark or facility.
 - f. Not adhering to other posted ballpark rules.
- Any team that has two or more players ejected in one game an immediate forfeit will be called by umpire.
- 3. Any excessive verbal abuse, physical altercation with umpire or staff, fighting with other participants will be an automatic suspension until said player meets with Recreation Director.
