Doug and Sandy Huff have lived and served in this community their entire lives. Both attended and graduated from Payson High School and have been prominent members of good ol' Payson, Utah ever since.

They have served together in the Lions Club for decades -- donating so much of their own money, time and talents to make Payson a

better place. Every single year, during Onion Days, you will find them selling onion rings or hot scones. You will also find them volunteering at the Salmon Supper, serving hot dogs for the library fundraiser, planting flowers at the Peteetneet, or holding community yard sales. All to better our town.

Many years ago, Doug and Sandy were in charge of the city Easter egg hunts. This was before plastic eggs...they literally hard boiled and dyed HUNDREDS of eggs for the event... themselves!

They have been volunteering for several years with Tabitha's Way Food Pantry. Helping to keep the shelves stocked, working in the stores, and helping with events.

They serve in the temple once a week and serve in their ward.

Doug volunteers a few hours every Tuesday at the Peteetneet, giving tours and helping with whatever is needed.

Sandy worked as an EMT on the Payson Ambulance many years ago. She and Doug then opened and ran the original Dalton's Restaurant. A beloved and delicious family restaurant where even more members of the community and neighboring towns fell in love with Sandy and her incredible recipes. They affectionately became everyone's favorite bosses and employed many people over the years and served home cooked meals to even more! A few times on Thanksgiving, they generously opened the doors of their restaurant to members of the homeless community at no charge and no questions asked. They served the most delicious Thanksgiving dinner, complete with pies and rolls and visited with them. They literally are the most kind hearted, giving people.

But most importantly, Doug and Sandy Huff are incredible friends and neighbors to everyone in the community. There's not a single week that Sandy didn't take a hot meal to someone, or a yummy dessert or even just stop by and visit a neighbor she thought might be feeling lonely. These two are the epitome of the type of citizen that everyone would want in their town, and Payson truly is a better place because of them.

Grand Marshals Stan & Marilyn Spencer

Stan and Marilyn have deep roots in Payson and have developed many lifelong relationships in the community. Being good citizens is of extreme importance. They are active in their church, they are good neighbors, and are always willing to help the community they love.

Stan was born and raised in Payson and spent much of his childhood years on

the farm or assisting his father who established several businesses in Payson. Following in his father's footprints, Stan continued the family's business in Payson—Spencer's Home Furnishings. His business endeavors led him to be active in the Chamber of Commerce and the Downtown Alliance. Stan served in the Army and continued in the Utah National Guard. He also worked at Geneva. Stan launched a multi-generational love for public safety when he joined the Payson Fire Department. He served as an active firefighter for 58 years. His passion for public safety has been passed on to future generations—resulting in two sons, a son-in-law, and several grandchildren serving as firefighters, emergency medical technicians, or in the public health profession. Stan and Marilyn served as EMT's during the early years of the department's establishment.

Marilyn's love for Payson began as a teenager, when her family moved to Payson from Idaho after her father accepted the position of Principal at Payson High School. She quickly fell in love with the small community and the people. In addition to being a dedicated wife and mother, she worked with Dr. Hall and Dr. Hogan in their office. This opened the door to a

38-year career at Mountain View Hospital, all of which was in sameday surgery. Marilyn has advocated for the fire service through the Payson Fire Department Auxiliary, an organization that supports the firefighters and raises funds for burn victims.

Stan and Marilyn have been married for 60 years (Do not tell anyone, they did not want a party). They have four children, sixteen grandchildren, and nine great-grandchildren. They are immensely supportive of their family, friendships, and community. Rain or shine, they show up! Sporting events, religious events, family celebrations, to them community means everything.





Why We Celebrate Golden Onion Days



Payson City's annual Golden Onion Days celebration will mark its 94th anniversary this year! This widely enjoyed tradition began back in 1929, started by the city's mayor, L.D. Stewart. The following is the official declaration as it appeared in the Payson Chronicle:

PROCLAMATION

Whereas many former residents of Payson City feel and have expressed a desire to come back to Payson and bring their friends with them for the purpose of meeting old friends and forming new friendships; and,

Whereas an organization has been perfected and a time appointed with the object of making it possible for all finding it convenient to meet here on the appointed time; and

Whereas September 12th, 13th, and 14th, 1929 is the appointed time and the occasion has been designated as "ONION HARVEST AND HOME COMING" celebration; and,

Whereas the citizens of Payson City are putting forth much effort to make this occasion a success and it is apparent that much good may come to Payson City and the inhabitants thereof and the friends who reside elsewhere, in making Payson and vicinity popular as an agriculture district and outstanding in the production of the onion.

Now therefore, I, L.D. Stewart, Mayor of Payson City, Utah do hereby proclaim September 12, 13, and 14, 1929, as the time for the first celebration known as "ONION HARVEST AND HOME COMING" and I urge all citizens to aid in every possible way to patronize and popularize this event.

I do further urge that all businesses, homes, and schools be closed Friday the 13th, and that all unite in making the parade an outstanding success.

In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and caused the corporate seal of Payson City, Utah, to be affixed this 6th day of September, 1929.

The celebration, later renamed "Payson City Golden Onion Days," was officially acknowledged by the Utah State Governor, Henry H. Blood, in 1933. He wrote: "Greetings to the celebrants at Payson this year. Your festivities are three-fold. You honor the onion as typical of the great agricultural resources of Payson and vicinity. You honor labor on the day set apart by the nation as labor's holiday. In paying tribute to the farmer and the working man you recognize basic factors in civilization. Also you honor the old home town, in an outburst of emotion which springs from the heart of human life. Thus I trebly congratulate you, and hope this celebration will bring you much joy and lasting happiness."

For 94 years, this wonderful city celebration has provided events which have delighted its citizens and kept them coming back each year for more! We invite you to enjoy this year's Golden Onion Days!

A number of exciting play features make the Payson City Aquatics Center a popular destination for children and their families. 
Johnny Utah
